

- 1 Get an undergraduate degree
 - TIP It can be in any field of studiy, but a Bachelor of Business Administration or Commerce may put you ahead in your journey to becoming a CPA.
- 2 Complete the CPA prerequisite courses
 - TIP If your undergraduate major is in accounting, you will likely meet all the CPA prerequisites during your undergraduate studies.
- 3 Complete the CPA Professional Education Program TIP You can study part-time and make money while you gain full-time work experience.
- 4 Pass the Common Final Examination
- 5 Become a CPA!
